The region is on the TGV (high speed train) rail route which stretches across France, making Wyndham Halcyon Retreat easily accessible for Parisian clientele. The closest station at La Souterraine is just 10 minutes drive away. France’s extensive network of auto routes means that getting there by car is also straightforward.

With a rich cultural and historical heritage, the region boasts well preserved abbeys, Roman churches and some stunning fortified castles. The capital of the region, Limoges, with its cobbled streets and flowing river, is just a short drive from Wyndham Halcyon Retreat.

GUEST ACTIVITIES

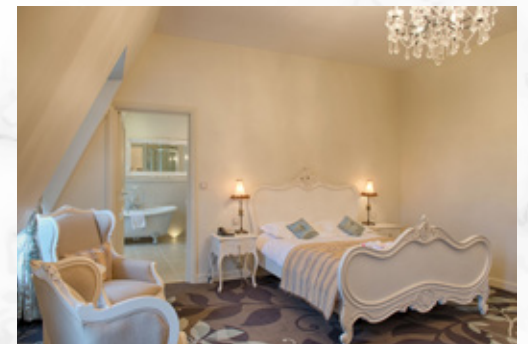
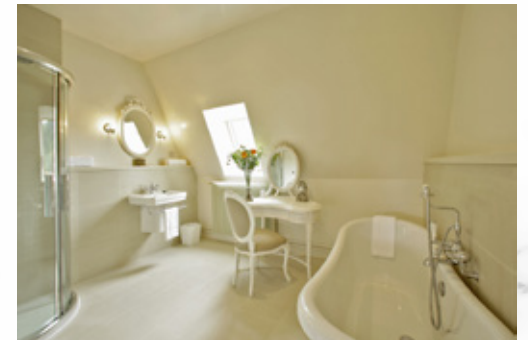
When not partaking in your wonderful wedding celebrations, your guests can enjoy all sorts of activities within the grounds.
